Everyone involved in the Boroughmuir Rugby Academy whether a player, Academy volunteer, coach, official, Club member or parent is expected to uphold Scottish Rugby's core values:

Leadership : Engagement : Achievement : Enjoyment : Respect

Boroughmuir Rugby Academy is committed to providing a safe, welcoming and friendly environment for all players, coaches, officials and visitors. To this end, the following Code of Conduct is in place for parents and carers:

- Remember that children and young people play for enjoyment as well as competition.
- Remember that your behaviour may affect not only your child but the other children and young people participating.
- Stay outside the field of play and in the Spectator's Area (where provided).
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.
- Always respect the match officials' decisions.
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success.
- Let the coaches do their job and do not confuse the players by telling them what to do.
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition and match officials.
- Never criticise a player for making a mistake. Remember that mistakes are an important part of learning and wellbeing
- Pass on any concerns that you have about the wellbeing of a child or young person to a club official.
